TAX BENEFITS

Anandi Empower Foundation is Section 8 company registered under Companies Act, 2013. Sec 8 Company is happens to a non-profit organization that is why they are exempted from some provisions of the Income Tax. They are also given numerous other deductions and other tax benefits. One of such exemption is under Section 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961, whereby donors may claim a 50% rebate against donations made. The registration accorded under Section 80G shall be valid for normally a period of one-three years.
